Rare curious pamphlet against the suffragan bishop of Constance, Melchior Fattlin (1490 to 1548) who had published some 'miraculous signs with which God chastised adherents of Luther'. With wit and eloquence the author rejects Fattlin's assertions, attacks superstition and defends Evangelical doctrine.  
The pseudonym 'Philadelphius Regius zu Costentz' remains undisclosed, though all historians of the Reformation at Constance have treated and investigated this important tract, especially A. Voegeli, Jörg Voegeli, Schriften zur Reformation in Konstanz 1519-1538, vol. II/2, p. 1038 ff., who thinks that Ambrosius Blarer is the real author.
